**Camp Policies and Procedures**

**Please Keep for your records**

**Camp Tuition:** \$50 is required at time of registration

No refunds will be given after June 15th. If your child attends any part of camp, a refund for weeks not attended cannot be given. If your child does not camp, but you do not notify Cambridge Camping by the June 15<sup>th</sup> deadline, a refund cannot be given. We retain the rights to dismiss any camper not complying with the appropriate behavior set out by camp.

### Bus Transportation

Bus service to and from camp is provided for all campers and is included in tuition. Site phone number and contact information will be finalized and sent home to families two weeks before camp begins.

Parents are responsible for getting their children to and from the correct bus-stop. CCA is not responsible for campers before checking-onto the bus in the morning or after checking-off the bus at the end of the day.

### Health Concerns:

If your child is sick, please don't send him/her to camp. Your child needs to be fever free for 24 hours without medication to be allowed in camp.

**Electronics:**

Please **DO NOT SEND** your child with spending money, electronics, or anything of value. **Your child is responsible for all items they bring to camp in the event that they are lost, stolen, or damaged.**

**Meals:**

Please have your camper bring their lunch and snack each day. Please, NO PEANUTS
