Daily activities for ages 8-13 include sports, swimming, canoeing, sailing, ropes course, crafts, hiking, environmental workshops, leadership courses, special events, camping, and more! Activities for ages 14-17 include leadership development, community projects, career workshops, as well as healthy recreation choices such as swimming, canoeing, sailing, tubing, games, ropes courses, hiking, camping and more!

5 and 11-day sessions available. Campers must go home between consecutive sessions.

**Session 1:** Monday, July 9 – Friday, July 13

**Session 2:** Monday, July 16 – Friday, July 27

**Housing:** Boys and girls are housed in separate areas of camp; activities are co-ed. Both boys and girls' cabins have toilets and sinks.

**Setting:** 400 acres of fields, hills and woods, with a mile of lakefront on Thompson Lake in Poland, Maine.

**Distance from Boston:** 140 miles from Cambridge, in Poland, Maine.

Activities include hiking, swimming, canoeing, sports and athletics, ropes course, nature, evening campfire, camp crafts. Each session is structured around friendly competition between cabins, based on athletics, daily inspection, spirit and outdoor challenges. Brantwood celebrated its 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2004!

All sessions are 15 days. Campers may only attend 1 session.

**Term 1:** June 27 – July 12

**Term 2:** July 16 – July 31

**Term 3:** August 4 – August 19

**Ages:** 11-15 years

**Enrollment:** 60 girls and 60 boys per session

**Housing:** Boys and girls have separate programs. Campers are assigned to cabins by age and number of years at Brantwood.

**Setting:** 350 acres in the Monadnock region of New Hampshire with an outdoor swimming pool. Another 100 acres on Silver Lake in Nelson, New Hampshire, where campers can hike, swim, canoe, and campout!

**Distance from Boston:** 70 miles from Cambridge, approximately 1 hour and 45 minute drive.

Bus from Riverside MBTA station in Newton is available and include in cost of tuition.

***All families pay \$250 tuition for 2 weeks at Brantwood Camp!***

Both camps have a wide variety of activities, including boating, swimming, archery, survival courses, high and low ropes courses, lacrosse, soccer, baseball, basketball, football, tennis and more. Also available are creative arts (including jewelry making, drama, mural painting, drawing, sculpture, dance and more. Older campers enjoy learning to create web pages in the Wired Woods program. Crossroads for Kids empowers youth from at-risk environments to achieve success!

**14 and 20-day sessions available.** Campers may not sign up for two 20-day sessions.

**Distance from Boston:** 45 miles, or less than 1 hours by car.

Bus from South Bay Center in Dorchester is included in tuition.

**Sliding scale tuition:** \$420 for 14-day sessions and \$600 for 20 day sessions.
