Daybreak Day Camp is a six-week program providing meaningful camp experiences to youngsters from under-resourced circumstances who demonstrate social, emotional, and behavioral challenges related to trauma or special needs. Campers' diagnoses may include ADHD, PTSD, mood disorders, autism spectrum disorders, anxiety, and other learning issues. With a 2:1 camper to staff ratio and an environment designed to be traumasensitive and responsive to camper needs, Daybreak Day Camp allows children who need a smaller program and extra support to fully experience the benefits of a summer day camp experience.
